


Manifestation Gifts:


- Hearing God (Grandmother WW2)
- 1 Thessalonians 5:19-21, "Do not put out the Spirit's fire; do not treat prophecies with contempt. Test everything. Hold on to the good."
- If we are going to expand our spiritual authority, we need to hear God speak.
 How do we prepare ourselves to hear God? And how does God speak?




- First, if we are going to hear God speak, and therefore expand our spiritual authority, then we need to prepare our hearts to listen. How do we prepare our hearts to listen for God?
- Worship can prepare your heart to hear God speak. (1 Chronicles 25:3, says Jeduthun & his 6 sons "prophesied, using the harp in thanksgiving and praising the Lord.")


- First, if we are going to hear God speak, and therefore expand our spiritual authority, then we need to prepare our hearts to listen.
- Worship can prepare your heart to hear God speak. (2 Kings 3:15, Elisha was seeking a word from the Lord, and he called for a harp. "While the harpist was playing, the hand of the Lord came upon Elisha and he said, 'This is what the Lord says...")




- First, if we are going to hear God speak, and therefore expand our spiritual authority, then we need to prepare our hearts to listen.
- Worship can prepare your heart to hear God speak by drawing us into God's presence (Ps 100), & focusing our full attention on God (noisy souls) (human level – talking to someone preoccupied)




- First, if we are going to hear God speak, and therefore expand our spiritual authority, then we need to prepare our hearts to listen.
- Stillness is also vital for preparing the heart to hear from God. Psalm 46:10, "Be still and know that I am God." Mark 1:35, "Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed."




- First, if we are going to hear God speak, and therefore expand our spiritual authority, then we need to prepare our hearts to listen.
- To prepare our hearts to hear from God, we must come expectantly. Hebrews 11:6, "And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists & that he rewards those who earnestly seek him." (introspection)





- God speaks in 6 ways:




- Second, if we are going to hear God speak, and therefore expand our spiritual authority, we need to know how God speaks.
- 1. God speaks through an audible voice.
 Sometimes we hear it out loud (Jesus;
 Paul; Cheryl). Sometimes it comes in a
 spontaneous utterance (as you speak you
 find yourself speaking words unformed
 that come from God) (Father blessing)




- Second, if we are going to hear God speak, and therefore expand our spiritual authority, we need to know how God speaks.
- 2. God speaks through a whisper or prompting (our thoughts) (texting)
- God speaks through pictures (dreams; visions; open visions) Acts 2:17-18 (praying for woman at AIM saw leering men)



- Second, if we are going to hear God speak, and therefore expand our spiritual authority, we need to know how God speaks.
- God speaks through our bodies & emotions. (decision – peace) (feel love word forming)
- 5. God speaks through a word in our mind's eye. (forgiveness)



- Second, if we are going to hear God speak, and therefore expand our spiritual authority, we need to know how God speaks.
- 6. God speaks through our 'knower' right to our spirits. (Laura healing songs)
